

Proposal Olivia Hendrickx Research Fund Clinical PhD 2024

The OHRF will provide PhD fellowships for projects in pediatric oncology. The projects should aim at the improvement of treatment and care of pediatric cancer patient. The translation of scientific knowledge to clinical practice is the primary aim. The OHRF will support both full time PhD projects (4y) and part-time (50%) clinical PhD projects (6y). The practical research can also be performed in an university laboratory.
